

## **Canadine Family - Broseley**

*Updated – August 2019*

These are the descendants of Abraham Cannadine and Sarah Gwin from Broseley, Shropshire. They are the ancestors of several of the Canadine families in Birmingham and London.

This document only includes limited information on those born after 1920. Most of the data is from public sources.

### 1. Family of Abraham Canadine (1754-1836) & Sarah Gwin

**Abraham Canadine (1754-1836).** The son of Abraham (b.1728) and Elizabeth Brown. He was born in 1754. He was a Cooper the same as his father.

Abraham married Sarah Gwin (1758-1822) on the 28th September 1783 at St. Leonard, Broseley.<sup>1 2</sup>

It is probably Abraham who was mentioned in a book on the Industrial revolution in Shropshire.<sup>3</sup>

*Petitions calling for the building of an iron bridge in the Gorge were circulated during the winter of 1773-1774, and the first formal meeting of the promoters took place at the house of Abraham Canadine, a Broseley cooper, and probably an innkeeper, on 15 September 1775.*

This refers to the building of the famous Ironbridge in Coalbrookdale; Broseley is a market town quite close by.

The meetings were also advertised in the Newspapers.<sup>4 5</sup>

Shrewsbury Chronicle Saturday 5<sup>th</sup> August 1775

*A respectable and numerous meeting of the Gentlemen of Broseley, and its environs; and the society of anglers in Bridgnorth, was convened at the house of Abraham Cannadines in Broseley, on the 28<sup>th</sup> ult., when those gentlemen, animated with a desire of promoting the laws for the preservation of the silh, &c., in the river Severn, unanimously joined the said society, whose spirited resolution and good example (it is to be hoped) will excite every well wisher of the public good to follow, the utility of which evidently appears in that part of the river that has been preserved, by the numerous increase of the small fry, and plenty of fish taken legally, and offered to sale at reasonable rates. In consideration of which they have resolved to preserve the fish &c., in the said river, from Upper Areley in the county of Stafford, to Atcham bridge in the county of Salop; and it is earnestly recommended to the gentlemen above and below those places to exert themselves in so laudable an undertaking, and establish means for the preservation of fish, &c., in all parts of the said river.*

Shrewsbury Chronicle Saturday 17<sup>th</sup> August 1776

Bridge

*Notice is hereby given, That Application is intended to be made to Parliament next Sessions, for leave to Build a Bridge over the River Severn, at a Place called the Sheep Wath, in the Parish fo Sutton Maddock, in the County of Salop, to the opposite Shore, in the Parish of Brosely, in the said County. Those who are desirous to promote such Undertaking, are requested to Meet at the House of Abraham Cannadine, in Brosely, on Thursday the 22<sup>nd</sup> Instant, at Eleven o'Clock in the Forenoon.*

Abraham's daughter in law was Jane Pritchard who may have been a relation of Thomas Farnolls Pritchard (d.1777) who was a Shrewsbury architect who first suggested a bridge.

Sarah died, age 64, in 1822 and was buried at All Saints, Broseley on the 28th September 1822.<sup>6 7</sup>

Abraham died, age 82, in 1836 and was buried at All Saints, Broseley on the 18th November 1836.<sup>8 9</sup>

All Saints replaced St. Leonard's on the same site and was completed by 1845 so it is not clear which Church was standing or its name in 1822 and 1836.

Abraham and Sarah had eight children.

**Richard Cannadine (1785-1818).** The son of Abraham and Sarah. He was christened on the 18th April 1785 at St. Leonard, Broseley.<sup>10</sup>

Richard married Jane Pritchard (1786-1861) at St. Leonard, Bridgnorth, Shropshire on the 2<sup>nd</sup> February 1809.<sup>11</sup> Richard was described as a 'China potter' on his son Richard's marriage certificate.

Richard died, aged 33, in 1818 and was buried at All Saints, Broseley on the 22nd June 1818.<sup>12 13</sup>

Jane is listed on a Broseley Tithe list of 1838 as an occupier. The owner was Samuel Lister.<sup>14</sup>

At the 1841 census Jane was living in Broseley; her daughter Jane's family was living with them.<sup>15</sup>

At the 1851 census, age 65, Jane was living with her daughter's family in Broseley. She was working as a China painter.

She may be the Jane Cannadine who died in 1861; registered at Madeley in the June quarter.<sup>16</sup>

**Jane Canadine (b.1812).** The daughter of Richard and Jane Pritchard. She was christened on the 30th August 1812 in Broseley.<sup>17</sup>

Jane married John (also James) Haynes (b.1813) on the 31st March 1832 at Sheinton, Shropshire.<sup>18</sup>

At the 1841 census they were living in Broseley with Jane's mother.

At the 1851 census they were living in Broseley.<sup>19</sup>

By the 1881 census John had died and Jane was living with her daughter Anne at Monks Coppenhall, Cheshire.<sup>21</sup>

**Selim Canadine (1814-1816)**. The son of Richard and Jane Pritchard. He was born in Broseley in 1814 and christened on the 4th of September.<sup>22</sup> Selim died in 1816 and was buried in Broseley on the 21st January 1816.<sup>23 24</sup>

**Selim Cannadine (1816-1893)**. Also Canadine. The second son with this name. The son of Richard and Jane Pritchard. He was christened on the 11th August 1816 in Broseley.<sup>25</sup>

Selim was involved in a court case in 1840.<sup>26</sup>

Staffordshire Advertiser 18 January 1840

*Wolverhampton Public Office, Wednesday Jan 15*

*Selim Cannadine charged Wm. Bentley with an assault. Both parties are omnibus conductors. The defendant was fined 5s and the costs.*

At the 1841 census Selim was living in Broseley.<sup>27</sup>

Selim was a witness in a court case in 1844.<sup>28</sup>

*Stealing a money parcel at Wolverhampton*

*William Porter, aged 20, was indicted for stealing a paper parcel containing two five pound Bank of England notes, one half sovereign, and six shillings, the property of Richard Cooper at Wolverhampton... Selim Cannadine was at Cook and Harris's spirit vaults, in Dudley Street, Wolverhampton, on the 7<sup>th</sup> November. The prisoner came in and offered a 5L. Bank of England note to change. He did not receive the change, and went away. He came again shortly afterwards and said he had got it changed. He had some spirits, and treated several persons.*

Selim married Mary Matthews (1818-1886) at Aston, Birmingham on the 24th September 1848.<sup>29 30</sup>

A cabman was the driver of a horse-drawn passenger vehicle for hire.

At the 1861 census they were living in Aston, Birmingham.<sup>32</sup>

The census image looks like 'John Cannadine' but it is probably Selim.

Selim was listed as a Beer Retailer, at 45 Wrentham Street, in Kelly's Directory of 1872.<sup>34</sup> He was also listed at 45 Wrentham Street in 1868, 1872, 1873 and 1878.<sup>35</sup>

At the 1881 census Selim and Mary were living in Aston, Birmingham.<sup>36</sup>

Mary died in 1886, age 65, registered at Birmingham in the September quarter.<sup>37</sup>

'Seline' is a faulty transcription or record.

Selim died in 1893; registered in the March quarter at Birmingham.<sup>39</sup> Selim was buried in Witton cemetery, Aston.<sup>40</sup>

**Richard Cannadine (1819-1878).** The son of Richard and Jane. He was christened on the 11<sup>th</sup> April 1819, at St. Leonard, Broseley.<sup>41</sup> His father was Richard and mother Jane.<sup>42</sup>

Richard's father had died before he was born.

At the 1841 census, age 22, he was at home in Broseley.

Richard married Ann Hazeldine (1822-1891) on the 29<sup>th</sup> November 1841 at St. Leonard, Broseley; registered at Madeley in the December quarter.<sup>43</sup>

He was described as a Bachelor, 'of age', a China Potter, Residence: Broseley. Father Richard Cannadine, China Potter. Jane was described as a Spinster, 'minor', Residence: Broseley, Father: Thomas Hazeledine, Mill-Wright. The witnesses were: Selim Canadine and Jane Haynes (Richard's brother and sister).<sup>44</sup>

Richard and Anne probably moved to London in about 1847.

At the 1851 census they were living in Shoreditch.<sup>45</sup>

Richard died, age 60, in 1878; registered at Hackney in the December quarter.<sup>47</sup>

Richard and Ann had five children.

*Their descendants are covered in a later section of this document.*

**Thomas Cannadine (1812-1887).** The son of Richard and Jane. Thomas was a cooper like his grandfather Abraham.

Thomas married Jane Roberts (b.1817) in about 1847.

At the 1851 census they were living in Wolverhampton.<sup>50</sup>

Thomas' age is probably 38 and not 28. The dates for both Thomas and Jane are contradictory in several of the records.

At the 1861 census they were living in Bilston.<sup>51</sup>

The ages do not seem to be correct for Thomas and Jane.

Thomas died, age 65, in 1887; registered at Birmingham in the December quarter.<sup>53</sup>

At the 1891 census Jane was living in Kent Street.<sup>54</sup>

**Joseph Canadine (c.1786).** Possibly the son of Abraham and Sarah Gwin. He was born in about 1786.

Joseph married Elizabeth Pritchard in about 1810.<sup>55</sup>

**Sarah Canadine (b.1812).** The daughter of Joseph and Elizabeth. She was baptised at Broseley on the 8<sup>th</sup> March 1812.

**Mary Cannadine (b.1789).** The daughter of Abraham and Sarah Gwin. She was christened on the 19<sup>th</sup> July 1789 at St. Leonard, Broseley.<sup>56 57</sup>

**Andrew Cannadine (bd.1793).** Andrew Fox. The son of Abraham and Sarah Gwin. He was christened on the 12<sup>th</sup> May 1793 at St. Leonard, Broseley.<sup>58 59</sup>

Andrew died as an infant in 1793 and was buried in Broseley on the 28<sup>th</sup> September.<sup>60</sup>

**Jane Cannadine (1795-1803).** The daughter of Abraham and Sarah Gwin. She was christened on the 15<sup>th</sup> February 1795 at St. Leonard, Broseley.<sup>61 62</sup>

It may be Jane who died in 1803 and was buried in Broseley on the 14<sup>th</sup> August.<sup>63</sup>

**Abraham Cannadine (1797-1850).** The son of Abraham and Sarah Gwin. He was christened on the 19<sup>th</sup> March 1797 at St. Leonard, Broseley.<sup>64</sup>



Abraham married Dinah Kendrick at St. Leonard, Broseley on the 7th April 1818.<sup>65</sup>

It may be Abraham who died in 1850; registered at Wolverhampton in the June quarter.<sup>66</sup>

Abraham and Dinah had two children.

**Henry Cannadine (1821-1877).** Also Canadine. The son of Abraham and Dinah. He was christened at St. Chad, Shrewsbury on the 5th August 1821.<sup>67</sup>

Henry married Louisa Meats (1820-1864) in 1856; registered at Nottingham in the June quarter.<sup>68</sup>

At the 1861 census they were living in Nottingham.<sup>69</sup>

Louisa died in 1864, registered at Nottingham in the September quarter.<sup>70</sup>

Henry died, aged 56, in 1877; registered at Derby in the June quarter.<sup>71</sup>

**Thomas Cannadine (b.1829).** The son of Abraham and Dinah. He was christened at St. Chad, Shrewsbury on the 11th January 1829.<sup>72</sup>

**Thomas Canadine (b.1800).** The son of Abraham and Sarah Gwin. He was christened on the 13th April 1800 at St. Leonard, Broseley.<sup>73 74</sup>

**Isaac Canadine (1803-1841).** Also Cannadine. The son of Abraham and Sarah. He was christened on the 14th May 1803 at St. Leonard, Broseley. He married Mary Anne Roberts (b.1808) on the 8th February 1831 at Wombridge.<sup>75 76 77</sup>

Isaac was listed in Kelly's directory for Shropshire in 1831 as a 'Cooper'.<sup>78</sup>

On February 27<sup>th</sup> 1833 Isaac was a juror at an inquest in Madeley. This was into the sudden death of Elizabeth York who died at the Bedlam furnace when her clothes caught fire.<sup>79</sup>

On the 8<sup>th</sup> of September 1834 Isaac was a juror at an inquest into the death of Keziah Griffiths. This took place at Broseley. It was decided that she died when her clothes accidentally caught fire.<sup>80</sup>

Issac died in 1841; registered at Madeley, Shropshire in the March quarter.<sup>81</sup>

At the 1841 census, age 33, Mary was living at Madeley.<sup>82</sup>

### **Broseley and Madeley**

Broseley and Madeley were described in Pigot's directory for Shropshire of 1835.<sup>85</sup>

*Broseley is a market-town, in the parish of its name, and franchise of Wenlock; 146 miles N.W. from London, 25 N. E. from Ludlow, 13 S. E. from Shrewsbury, and 4 E. from Wenlock; situate on the Severn, which river separates it from Madeley, Ironbridge, and Colebrook-Dale; and on the road from Worcester to Shrewsbury. In ancient records it is written Bur-wardesley, probably deriving that appellation from a family of the name of Burward, to which it formerly belonged. It consists principally of one long street, with smaller ones branching off irregularly, leading to the different collieries and other works; the former of which are extensive. Their produce is chiefly appropriated on the spot to various iron furnaces, pot-teries, &c. as well as to the manufacture of glazed pipes (for which it has been long noted), fire-bricks, tiles, &c. The town is within the jurisdiction of the borough of Wenlock: courts-leet for the manor are held in the town-ball, in April and October; at the latter of which four constables are appointed: and a court of requests, for the recovery of debts under 40s. is held generally every alternate Wednesday. The places of worship are, the parish church, a chapel of ease at Jackfield (in this parish), two chapels for Baptists, and one for the Wesleyan Methodists. The church, which is dedicated to St. Leonard, has, with the*

exception of the tower (which is of stone,) been rebuilt of brick. The living is a perpetual curacy, in the patronage of the Blythe family: the Rev. Townsend Forester is the present incumbent. The market is held on Wednesday; and the fairs on the last Tuesday in April, and the 28th of October. The parish of Broseley contained, in 1811, 4,850 inhabitants; in 1821, 4,814; and in 1831, 4,299; the reduced population being attributed to the depression of the iron trade.

Madeley, or Madeley Market, is a parish and market town, in the same liberties as Broseley; the town extending to Coalbrook Dale, which is accounted a part of it, and connected therewith in its trade and history. The iron-works of this parish are considerable; the forges, mills, and steam-engines, with all their vast machinery, and the flaming furnaces and smoking lime-kilns, form a spectacle horribly sublime; while the stupendous iron arch, bestriding the Severn, gives these scenes a yet nearer resemblance to the ideas in romance. This famous bridge was built in the year 1779, the whole having been previously cast in open sand; all the principal parts were erected in three months, without any accident to the work or workmen, or the least obstruction to the navigation of the river. The span of the arch is one hundred feet six inches, and the height, from the base line to the centre, forty feet; the total weight of iron being three hundred and seventy-eight tons. This great work, which has given name to a part of the parish, Ironbridge, has every claim to attention as an effort of great mechanical genius. The places of worship are, the parish church, dedicated to All Saints, chapels for Wesleyan Methodists, and one for Roman Catholics. A new church is about to be erected for the accommodation of the inhabitants of Ironbridge. The living of Madeley is a discharged vicarage, in the patronage of Sir Edward Kynaston, Bart.: the Rev. George Edmonds is the present incumbent. The house of industry, erected in 1797, at an expense of about £1,100. is a commodious building. At Coalport, two miles from Ironbridge, are the china manufactories, which are well worth the minute inspection of the visitant; as indeed is the whole of this curious and romantic neighbourhood; where may be seen winding glens, vast hills, and hanging woods: while the bosom of the noble Severn, which so essentially contributes to the prosperity of this district, in bearing away the articles of trade produced here, adds also to the general beauty of the country through which it glides. The market is held on Friday at Ironbridge; and the fairs at Madeley, on the 26th of January, the 29th of May, and the 12th of October. The parish of Madeley contained, by the census of 1821, 5,379 inhabitants, and by that for 1831, 5,822.

## **2. Descendants of Richard Cannadine (1819-1878) & Ann Hazeldine**

**Mary Cannadine (b.1843).** Mary Jane. The daughter of Richard and Ann Hazeldine. She was born in 1843; registered at Madeley in the September quarter.<sup>86</sup>

At the 1851 census, age 7, she was at home in Shoreditch.

Mary married Abel Andrew on the 17<sup>th</sup> April 1862; registered at Shoreditch in the June quarter. Abel was aged 21, a bachelor, Grocer's assistant and was living at 4 Charles Street. His father was William Andrew a solicitor. Mary, age 18, a spinster, was living at 6 William Street. Her father was Richard Cannadine an engineer. The witnesses were W Cleland and Ann Cannadine.<sup>87</sup>

Ann Cannadine was probably Mary's mother.

**Richard Cannadine (1847-1853).** Richard Thomas. The son of Richard and Ann Hazeldine. He was born on the 15<sup>th</sup> November 1847 and baptised at Christ Church, Hoxton on the 17<sup>th</sup> January 1848; registered at Shoreditch in the December quarter. His father's occupation was given as an Engineer. They were living at 9 Avebury St.<sup>88 89</sup>

At the 1851 census, age 3, he was at home in Shoreditch.

Richard died, age 5, in 1853, and was buried at St. John the Baptist, Hoxton on the 17<sup>th</sup> July. The family were at Avebury Street.<sup>90</sup>

**Alfred Cannadine (b.1850).** The son of Richard and Ann Hazeldine. He was born on the 19<sup>th</sup> March 1850; registered at Shoreditch in the June quarter. He was baptised on the 10<sup>th</sup> May. They were living at 9 Avebury Street.<sup>91 92 93</sup>

At the 1851 census, age 1, he was at home in Shoreditch  
At the 1871 census, age 21, he was at home in Shoreditch and working as a Solicitor's clerk.

Probably in about 1871 he was listed in the Civil service records for evidence of age on entry.<sup>94</sup>

Alfred married Mary Ann Barford (b.1849) on the 1<sup>st</sup> November 1880, at St. Thomas' Church, Bethnal Green.<sup>95</sup>

He was a bachelor, age 30, living at 10 Hope Street. He was working as a Boot Laster. His father was Richard Cannadine an Engineer. Mary was a spinster, age 31, living at Ada Street. Her father was James Barford a Printer. The witnesses were William Aheney and Ellen Barford.

At the 1881 census they were living in Bethnal Green.<sup>96</sup>

George married Hannah Maria Robinson (1854-1922) in 1874; registered at Bethnal Green in the September quarter.

They were married on the 12<sup>th</sup> July 1874, at St. Thomas, Bethnal Green. He was aged 23, a bachelor, living at 32 Charles St. His father was Richard Cannadine an Engineer. She was aged 20, a spinster, living at 111 Brick Lane. Her father was Robert Robinson a labourer. The witnesses were: Charles Brooks and Maria Hannah Moleman.<sup>100 101</sup>

At the 1881 census they were living in Shoreditch.<sup>102</sup>

He was admitted to St. Paul's School, Hackney on the 28<sup>th</sup> April 1881.<sup>108</sup>

At the 1891 census, age 16, he was at home in Hackney and employed as a cardboard worker.

William married Eliza Rebecca Boone (1867-1899) in about 1892.

Eliza died in 1899; registered at Edmonton in the December quarter.<sup>109</sup>

William married Florence Gertrude May Oberdries (1877-1949) in 1898; registered at Islington in the June quarter.<sup>110</sup>

William was convicted of deserting his wife (Florence) and his son.<sup>111</sup>

*Shameful Desertion and Elopment. William George Cannadine, twenty eight, was charged with deserting his wife and son, who had become chargeable to the parish of St. Mary, Islington. The wife said they had been married about two years, and some few months ago prisoner brought another woman home and introduced her as a friend. Subsequently prisoner eloped with her. Mr. Ford, relieving officer, found that prisoner had been living in Manchester with the woman for the last five weeks. A sad feature of the case was the death of one child, which the deserted wife had worked hard to keep. Mr. Paul Taylor said it was a blackguardly thing to desert a wife in this way,*

and sentenced prisoner to twenty one days' hard labour and ordered him to pay £2 9s. 5d. Costs, or an additional fourteen days.

At the 1901 census, age 27, William was living in Southport and working as a bar man and as a tram conductor.<sup>112</sup> This seems to fit with the story of leaving his wife, described above.

Florence refers to herself as a 'widow' but we think George may not have died until much later and he may be the William G Cannadine who died, age 63, in 1936; registered at Basford, Nottingham. His daughter Marion was married in Basford in 1919 and he may have been living near or with his daughter.<sup>114</sup>

Florence died, age 72, in 1949; registered at Edmonton in the September quarter.<sup>115</sup>

William had several children.

**Ernest Cannadine (1893-1982).** Ernest Edward William. The son of William and Eliza. He was born on the 6<sup>th</sup> April 1893; registered at Bethnal Green on 15<sup>th</sup> May. He was born at 66 Minerva Street.<sup>116 117</sup>

At the 1901 census, age 8, he was staying with his grandmother (Hannah Cannadine) at Bethnal Green.

Ernest, age 8, was admitted to Atley Road School, Tower Hamlets on 10<sup>th</sup> March 1902.<sup>118</sup>

At the 1911 census, age 18, Ernest was staying with his 'grandparents', at Bow. It is not clear who these people are.<sup>119</sup>

It looks as though they were divorced and Alice re-married twice to John J Flindall in 1940 and to Victor Fitzsimons in 1951.<sup>122 123</sup>

Ernest married Elizabeth Box in 1921; registered at Hackney in the June quarter.<sup>124</sup>

Ernest and Elizaebeth are listed on several electoral registers in Hackney in the period 1922 to 1964; living at 261 Glyn Road, 21 St.John's Mansions, and 3 Nisbet House, in Hackney.<sup>125</sup>

Ernest died, age 89, in 1982; registered at Poplar in the March quarter.<sup>126</sup>

Ernest had six children.

**Alice Cannadine (bd.1915).** Alice E J or E K. The daughter of Ernest and Alice. She was born in 1915; registered at Poplar in the June quarter.<sup>127</sup> Alice died as an infant the same year.<sup>128</sup>

**Jane Cannadine (b.1916).** Jane A. The daughter of Jane and Alice. She was born in 1916; registered at Poplar in the December quarter.<sup>129</sup>

Jane married John V Lewis in 1938; registered at Poplar in the December quarter.<sup>130</sup>

**Nellie Cannadine (b.1918).** The daughter of Ernest and Alice. She was born in 1918; registered at West Ham in the December quarter.<sup>131</sup>

She may be the Nellie who married Cecil J Law in 1981; registered at Lewisham in the June quarter.<sup>132</sup>

**Kathleen Cannadine (b.1921).** The daughter of Ernest and Elizabeth. She was born in 1921; registered at Hackney in the June quarter.<sup>133</sup>

Kathleen married Sydney G Hannaford in 1946; registered at Hackney in the June quarter.<sup>134</sup>

**Ruth Cannadine (b.1924).** The daughter of Ernest and Elizabeth. She was born in November 1924; registered at Hackney in the March quarter 1925.<sup>135</sup>

Ruth married Albert F Dekker in 1951; registered at Hackney in the March quarter.<sup>136 137</sup>

Ruth and Albert had three children: Ruth Dekker, Catherine Dekker, Paul Dekker.

**John Cannadine (b.1936).** The son of Ernest and Elizabeth. He was born in 1936; registered at Hackney in the September quarter.<sup>138</sup>

John married Kay Long in 1961; registered at Shoreditch in the December quarter.<sup>139</sup>

John and Kay had two children. Julia Cannadine (b.1964), Jayne Cannadine (b.1968).<sup>140</sup>

**May Cannadine (1894-1902).** May Rose. The daughter of William and Eliza. She was born in 1894; registered at Shoreditch in the September quarter.<sup>141</sup>

At the 1901 census, age 6, she was living at Bethnal with her grandparents.

She was recorded at School in 1902.<sup>142</sup> Her brother Ernest and sister Marie were at the same school.

Arthur enlisted in the Army in October 1915 and was posted to the Mesopotamian Expeditionary Force with the 9<sup>th</sup> Battalion of the Royal Warwickshire regiment.<sup>255</sup>

He gave his age as 37 years 8 months and next of kin as Ada Cannadine. They were living at 8 Vanns Buildings, Cooksey Road, Birmingham. He was a private. His condition was described as 'fair' and height given as 5ft 3-1/2 in.

The Mesopotamian Expeditionary Force fought in the Middle East and in 1916 were involved in several actions in Iraq mainly against Turkish forces. One of the main purposes was to protect Oil supplies.

The 9<sup>th</sup> Battalion of the Royal Warwickshire Regiment served in Mesopotamia from 1916-1918; they had previously been at Gallipoli but were moved to Mesopotamia in January 1916. Arthur joined them on 6<sup>th</sup> March 1916 and served until 20<sup>th</sup> May 1919.

He was awarded the British War Medal and the Victory Medal.

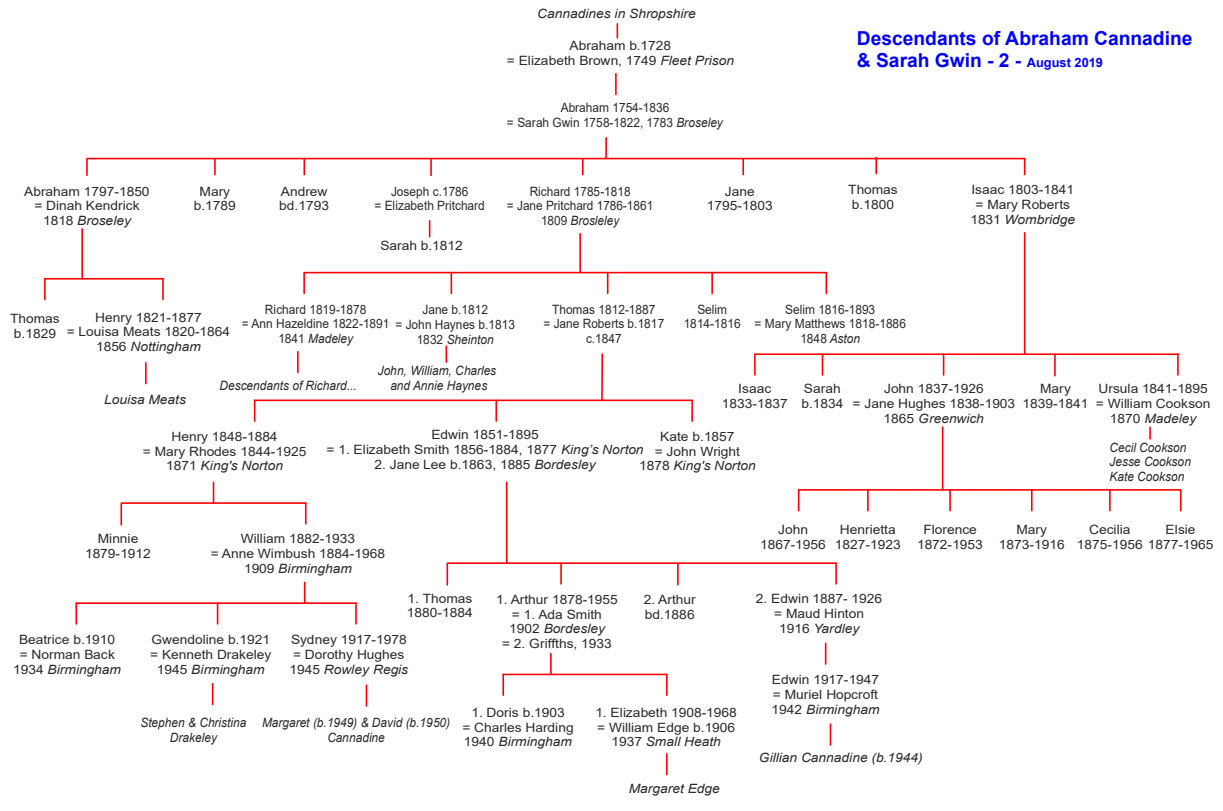
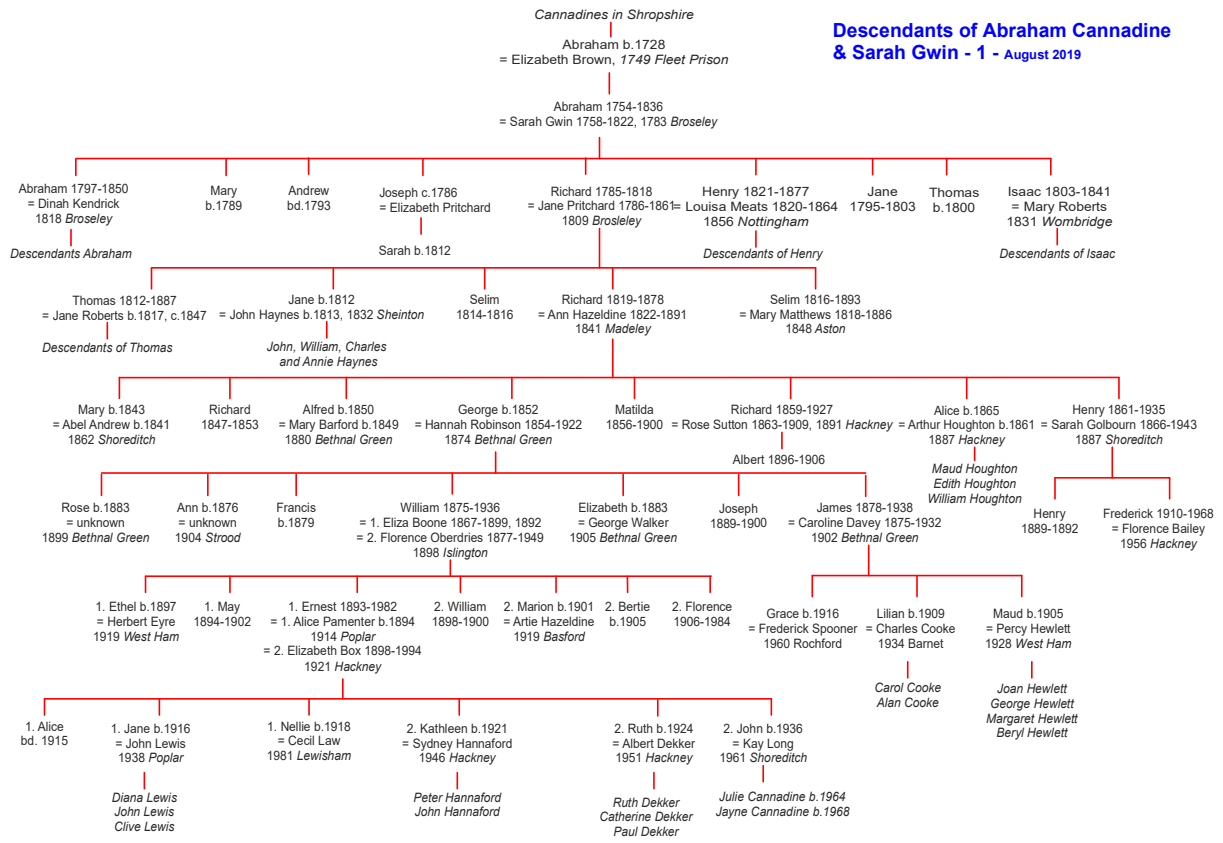
