

Thomas Canadine & Elizabeth Pickford and their descendants

Updated – February 2016

Many modern Canadine families are descendants of Abraham Canadine (1766-1856) and Martha Phillips (1770-1844) who lived in Shropshire in the 18th century. Abraham and Martha had several children: Richard, Mary, Sarah, James, Thomas, William, Anne, Elizabeth and Abraham. This document describes the descendants of their son Thomas who married Elizabeth Pickford and also the descendants of James who married Harriet Maylett.

This document only includes very limited information on those born after 1920. Most of the data is from public sources.

1. Thomas Canadine & Elizabeth Pickford and their descendants

Thomas Canadine (1802-1877). The son of Abraham and Martha. He was born in 1802 in Belbroughton.

Thomas married Elizabeth Pickford (1806-1850) on the 15th February 1829 in Kidderminster.^{1 2} Elizabeth was also known as 'Betsey'.

At the 1841 census they were living in Belbroughton.³

Thomas was mentioned in the Will of his father Abraham of 27th November 1848.⁴ He was one of the Executors along with James Hayward (his brother in law) and Henry Cutler a friend of his father. The Will was proved on the 19th July 1856. Most of the estate was left in trust to these three for them to split the estate between Thomas and the other surviving children or the grandchildren.

... As to one other of the said sixth parts or shares unto the said Thomas Canadine for his own use and benefit to whom I give and bequeath the same accordingly...

Thomas and Henry Cutler were the surviving executors in 1856.

Elizabeth died, age 44, in 1850, and was buried at Holy Trinity, Belbroughton on the 23rd July 1850.⁵

At the 1851 census, age 49, Thomas was living in Belbroughton with his father Abraham. He was described as a widower and was working as a Wood collier.

In 1856 Thomas was living in one of the houses next to the Queen's Head in Belbroughton.⁶

At the 1861 census, age 59, he was lodging with the Lacey family in Belbroughton.⁷

Deaths. Canadine April 24, at Wednesbury, aged 75, Thos Canadine late of Belbroughton, in this County.

Thomas and Elizabeth had several children.

Martha Canadine (1830-1848?). Also Cannadine. The daughter of Thomas and Elizabeth. She was christened on the 4th February 1830 in Belbroughton.¹⁰ There is also a baptism date of 21st November 1829 at Belbroughton; the exact date is not certain.

At the 1841 census, age 10, she was at home in Belbroughton.

There is also uncertainty about her death as there are 2 records for Martha Canadine, one in 1844 and the other in 1848.^{11 12}

Edwin Canadine (1832-1887). Also Edward. Also Cannadine/Canedine/Carradine. The son of Thomas and Elizabeth. He was christened on the 21st February 1832 in Belbroughton.¹³

At the 1841 census, age 7, he was at home in Belbroughton.

At the 1851 census, age 19, he was living with his father and grandfather in Belbroughton. He was working as a Wood collier.

Edwin married Ellen Cogzell (1832-1892) on the 15th March 1857 at Old Swinford; registered at Stourbridge in the March quarter.^{14 15} Her father was James Cogzell (1797-1859) and her mother was Catherine Partridge (1796-1837).

Edwin is listed as Greengrocer at 44 Coventry Street, Stourbridge in 1860.¹⁶

Edwin was listed on his son Edward's marriage certificate in 1880. He was described as a general dealer.

Edwin died, age 57, in 1887; registered at Hereford in the December quarter.²⁰

At the 1891 census Ellen was living in Stourbridge.²¹

Edwin and Ellen had eight children.

Edward Canadine (1857-1919). Thomas James. The son of Edwin and Ellen. He was born on the 29th November 1857 in Old Swinford.²³

At the 1861 census, age 5, he was at home in Stourbridge.

At the 1871 census, age 17, Edward was in Stourbridge working as a domestic servant.²⁴

Albert Hazeldine may be the person who married Edward's cousin, Beatrice Canadine (b.1876).

Edward married Ada Emily Sturmy (also Sturmeay, 1863-1932) on the 27th December 1880; registered at Birmingham in the December quarter.²⁵

They were married at St. David, Birmingham. Edward was described as; age 25, bachelor, a General Dealer. His father was Edwin Canadine a General Dealer. Emily was; age 18, a spinster, her father was William Sturmy a House Decorator. They were both living in Barford Street, Birmingham.

The witnesses were William Sturmeay and Ellen Canadine.²⁶

Edward was admitted to the asylum at Hereford on the 30th May 1899. He was discharged a few months later on the 9th January 1900.²⁹

Edward died, age 63, on the 22nd March 1919 and is buried in Hereford City cemetery; registered at Hereford in the March quarter.^{32 33}

Emily died, age 68, on the 16th of March 1932 and is buried in Hereford City cemetery; registered at Hereford in the March quarter.^{34 35}

There is a memorial.³⁶

Edward and Emily had eight children.

Emily Canadine (b.1881). Ada Emily. The daughter of Edward and Emily. She was born in 1881; registered at Hereford in the December quarter.³⁷

At the 1891 census, age 9, she was at home in Hereford.

At the 1901 census, age 20, she was living at Hereford General Hospital working as a servant.³⁸

Emily married Alfred Ernest Boulter in 1905; registered at Hereford in the September quarter.³⁹

At the 1911 census they were living in Hereford.⁴⁰

At the 1901 census she was living and working at Byford Court, Hereford.⁴²

Ellen married Frederick William Parsons in 1910; registered at Hereford in the March quarter.⁴³

At the 1911 census they were living at 6 Pwlygarth Street Kenfig Hill Ne Bridgend.⁴⁴

Frederick was a Coal Miner. No children had been born by 1911

Jessie Canadine (1885-1890). Jessie Mary Eliza. The daughter of Edward and Emily. She was born in 1885.

Jessie was killed in a street accident, age 4, in 1890.⁴⁵ There was a report in the local paper.⁴⁶

Hereford Times 1890

A horse attached to a tea van belonging to Mr. Thomas Parry of Coningsby Street, Hereford, bolted, knocking the wheels off. Horse and Trap of Mr. F. Hawkins of the Sugwas Court collided with horse and trap of Mr David Jones of Rolisford, Moccas, at Whitecross. Mr Hawkins and one horse knocked unconscious. Horse & cab belonging to the Merton Hotel, driven by George Powell, with four passengers, driven over the chest of Jessie Canadine aged 5, daughter of Mr Edward Canadine of Maylord Street, The four male passengers 'immediately got out' so she could be taken to the Infirmary where her injuries were attended to. Thomas Davies of Builth knocked down by butcher's horse & cart in High Street.

Inquest on the Death of Jessie Mary Eliza Canadine aged 4. Verdict accidental Death.

Mary Canadine (b.1888). Mabel Mary. Also known as Mary. The daughter of Edward and Emily. She was born in 1888; registered at Hereford in the March quarter.⁴⁷

At the 1891 census, age 3, (as Mary) she was living at home in Hereford.

Mary married Herbert Jesse Worrall in 1908; registered at Hereford in the June quarter.⁴⁸

Mabel Canadine (b.1890). Mabel Gertrude. The daughter of Edward and Emily. She was born in 1890; registered at Hereford in the March quarter.⁴⁹

At the 1911 census, age 21, she was at home in Hereford and working as a Dressmaker.

Mabel married Harry Bennett in 1911; registered at Hereford in the June quarter.⁵⁰

Clara Canadine (b.1895). Clara Alice. The daughter of Edward and Emily. She was born in 1894 and baptised in Hereford on the 18th December 1894; registered at Hereford in the March quarter.^{51 52}

At the 1901 census, age 6, she was at home in Hereford

At the 1911 census, age 16, she was at home in Hereford and working as an 'Improver dressmaking'.

Clara married Frank John Parsons in July 1914 at Pyle & Kenfig; registered at Hereford in the September quarter. The bride's parish was St. Nicholas Hereford.⁵³

Annie Canadine (b.1897). Annie Louisa. The daughter of Edward and Emily. She was born in 1897 and baptised on the 29th March 1897, at Hereford; registered at Hereford in the June quarter.^{54 55}

At the 1901 census, age 4, she was at home at Hereford

At the 1911 census, age 14, she was working as a servant in the household of Lt. Colonel Vivian Henry.⁵⁶

Marriage. A pretty wedding took place at St. Nicholas Church, on Saturday last, the contracting parties being Private Alfred Pritchard, of the K.S.I.L and Miss Annie Canadine, of 47 Berrington Street, Hereford. The best man was Mr. Bert Worrall, and the bride attended by Miss Maggie Canadine, was given away by Private H. Bennett. The happy couple afterwards, left for Shrewsbury, where a short honeymoon was spent. Both were the recipients of many useful presents. The bridegroom was formerly employed at Barrs Court Station.

Margaret Canadine (b.1899). Margaret Rose. Also Margaret. The daughter of Edward and Emily. She was born in 1899; registered at Hereford in the December quarter.⁶⁰

At the 1901 census, age 1, she was at home in Hereford.

At the 1911 census, age 11, she was at home in Hereford.

Margaret married a Charles D Bounds in 1921; registered at Hereford in the December quarter.⁶¹

Margaret and Charles had four children including Eric George Bounds (b.1927).

Ellen Canadine (b.1860). The daughter of Edwin and Ellen. She was christened on the 26th February 1860 at Old Swinford.⁶²

At the 1861 census, age 1, she was at home in Stourbridge.

At the 1871 census, age 11, she was at home in Stourbridge

At the 1881 census, age 21, she was working as a housemaid in Cheshire.⁶³

Ellen was married in 1885 (to Joseph Walters or Arthur Biddle); registered at Stourbridge in the December quarter.⁶⁴

James Canadine (1862-1872). The son of Edwin and Ellen. He was born on the 7th April 1862 and christened on the 16th August 1863.⁶⁵

At the 1871 census, age 9, he was at home in Stourbridge.

James died, age 10, on the 12th April 1872.⁶⁶

Eliza Canadine (b.1864). Also Elisa. The daughter of Edwin and Ellen. She was born in 1864; registered at Stourbridge in the June quarter.⁶⁷

At the 1871 census, age 6, she was at home in Stourbridge.

At the 1881 census, age 16, she was at home in Stourbridge

Eliza married Thomas Alexander Wyer (b.1864) on the 25th November 1889; registered at Stourbridge in the December quarter.⁶⁸

At the 1891 census they were living in Lye, Worcestershire.

Eliza and Thomas had several children; Albert (b.1889), William Henry (b.1892), Elsie May (b.1899).

Thomas Canadine (1865-1907). The son of Edwin and Ellen. He was born in 1865; registered at Stourbridge in the September quarter.⁶⁹

At the 1871 census, age 5, he was at home in Stourbridge.

At the 1881 census, age 15, he was at home in Stourbridge

He may be the Thomas Canadine listed in a trade directory in 1886.⁷⁰

At the 1891 census, age 26, he was at home in Stourbridge and working as a labourer.

Thomas died, age 42, in 1907; registered at Billesdon in the December quarter.⁷¹

William Canadine (1868-1920). The son of Edwin and Ellen. He was born in 1868; registered at Stourbridge in the June quarter.⁷²

At the 1871 census, age 2, he was at home in Stourbridge

At the 1881 census, age 12, he was at home in Stourbridge

At the 1891 census, age 22, he was at home Stourbridge and working as a Leather warehouseman

William married Susannah Wyatt (1870-1957) in 1894; registered at Nottingham in the June quarter.⁷³

William died, age 52, in 1920; registered at Nottingham in the March quarter.⁷⁶

Susannah remarried in 1922 (to Arthur Redgard); registered at Nottingham in the December quarter.⁷⁷ Susannah died, age 87, in 1957; registered at Nottingham in the June quarter.⁷⁸

William and Susannah had several children.

Frederick Canadine (1894-1927). Frederick Wyatt. The son of William and Susannah. He was born in 1894 and baptised on the 19th December 1894 at St. Saviour, Nottingham; registered at Nottingham in the December quarter.⁷⁹ The family were living at 76 Sutton Street, Nottingham.⁸⁰

At the 1901 census, age 6, he was at home in Nottingham.

At the 1911 census, age 16, he was at home in Nottingham and working as an errand boy for a Grocer.

Frederick joined the Army in the First World War initially in the same regiment as his brother William (Notts. & Derby Sherwood Forester, Regimental Number 3856) and later (after 1916) was serving in the Royal Welsh Fusiliers. He was a Private.

Frederick served in France from 27th October 1915 and was injured on the 26th June 1916 when the regiment was in France preparing for the first day of the battle of the Somme (see notes on William). His brother was injured at the same time and died from his injuries.

Frederick left the Army on the 12th March 1919 and was awarded the 1915 Star, Victory, and British War medals.⁸¹

Frederick died, age 32, in 1927; registered at Nottingham in the June quarter.⁸²

William Canadine (1897-1916). Also Cannadine. The son of William and Susannah. He was born in 1897; registered at Nottingham in the December quarter.⁸³

At the 1901 census, age 3, he was at home in Nottingham.

At the 1911 census, age 13, he was at home in Nottingham

William joined the Territorial Army (Notts. & Derby Sherwood Foresters regiment No. 3859) as a Private on the 8th March 1915. His medical report gives his age as 19 years 5 months and Height 5ft 10 inches; he was actually 17.⁸⁴ Judging from the Regimental numbers it looks as though both brothers signed up on the same day.

William was in England until the 27th October 1915 and then moved with the 1/7th Regiment (Robin Hoods) to France, near Arras in November 1915. Just before the Battalion's scheduled move to Foncquevilliers (as part of the preparation for the Battle of the Somme which opened on 1st July 1916) William was seriously wounded.

On the 26th or 27th June whilst working in the advanced trenches he suffered a gunshot wound to the skull. He was moved to 3/46 Field Ambulance before being taken on to 20th Casualty Clearing Station with a compression fracture of the skull. He died the following day.

This was reported in the local paper.⁸⁵

CANADINE, Died of wounds June 28th 1916, Private W Canadine, Sherwood Foresters, age 18. Mother, father, brothers.

An extract from the diary of Private Sidney Dore from the same company mentions this.

24. Weather - very unsettled. Nothing doing for once. Bumping fatigue at night. Heavy bombardment begins. Very bad week for fatigues. Many casualties. Heavy thunderstorms in the week.

25. Bombardment continued with great violence. Working in the advanced trench. Up to the waist in water.

26. Bombardment continued. 4 casualties while in the advanced trench. Canadine brothers wounded. Drying clothes.

Sidney Dore was later killed on the first day of the Somme.

William's brother Frederick was also serving in the same company.⁸⁶

Margaret Monnie a Canadine descendant and resident of Ansonia in the 1950's writes:-

There were many English people living on our street and elsewhere in Ansonia when I was a child who had come from the Birmingham, England area. Many had known each other in England. In fact a part of Derby was once called Birmingham and the company where my father worked was once called Farrel/Birmingham.

The home that Eliza Colerick Canadine purchased in 1905 was later given by her to her granddaughter Eliza Barber Cope (my grandmother) who passed it to her 3 daughters. My mother moved back there with her sister Elsie when my father died. Since Lillian was living in her husband's home, after my mother's death, we sold the original house in 1997. It held generations of memories. I have the original deed. I also have a 4 generation picture taken about 1916 in the back of the house of Eliza Colerick Canadine, Ellen Canadine Pickering, Eliza Barber Cope and Marjorie Cope, my mother, then about 3. I also have hanging in my living room a beautiful oil portrait of Eliza Colerick Canadine painted in Birmingham, probably in the 1880's.

After the death of James Canadine, Eliza agreed to emigrate to the US. Her daughter Ellen and second husband Herbert Pickering were already there. Eliza travelled with her son Herbert and granddaughter Eliza (Annie) Barber April 24, 1904. George and Harriet followed in Sept 1905. Their son George first went to Canada and then to Ansonia.

Eliza died on the 13th November 1919 in Ansonia and was buried in Pine Grove Cemetery.

George and Harriet are both buried in Pine Grove Cemetery, Ansonia, Connecticut. Their only child was George Shutt born February 4, 1881 in Birmingham

Ellen Canadine (1861-1940). The daughter of James and Eliza. She was born on the 6th April 1861; registered in Kidderminster in the June quarter 1861.¹⁸⁷

She is listed on the 1861 census when she was only 4 hours old.
At the 1871 census, age 10, she was at home in Kidderminster.

At the 1881 census Ellen was living at 31 Wood Street, Kidderminster with Eliza Jane Colerick (her cousin) with their Aunt Susan Cook (néé Colerick).¹⁸⁸

Ellen was married on the 13th May 1883 in St George's Church, Kidderminster to Charles Henry Barber (b.1856); registered at Kidderminster in the June quarter.¹⁸⁹

*Charles emigrated to the US sometime in the 1880's and allegedly met his death by accident in upstate New York, near Amsterdam, where he went to seek work in the carpet mills. Ellen and Charles had one child: Eliza Ann Barber born 4th December 1884 in Kidderminster.*¹⁹⁰

In 1891, Ellen married a second time in Kidderminster to Herbert Pickering (who was either a widow or divorced, as he had two daughters, Sarah and Mary, both of whom were later living in the USA).

At the 1901 census Ellen and Herbert were living in Smethwick.¹⁹¹

A year or so later they emigrated to the USA (Connecticut).

*Ellen emigrated to the US in June 4, 1903 aboard the Teutonic out of Liverpool to New York and settled in Ansonia, Connecticut, joining Henry Pickering who had proceeded her. She was accompanied by Herbert Henry Pickering, born January 4, 1895 to Eliza Jane Colerick and Benjamin Pritchard Sadler. When Eliza Jane Colerick Sadler died in childbirth after delivering her second son Herbert, Ellen took him to raise him. Herbert's older brother, Frederick Sadler, remained in the care of their father. Although not legally adopted, Herbert went by the name Pickering until about the age of 13.*¹⁹²

Ellen died April 8, 1940 in Ansonia and was buried in Pine Grove Cemetery with Henry Pickering. Herbert married Charlotte James and had four children.

Ellen is the great grandmother of Margaret Monnie who has provided most of the information for this branch of the Canadines. Her son William Monnie (b.1981) is now the only male descendant of James Canadine.

William Canadine (b.1868). The son of James and Eliza. He was born in 1868 in Birmingham; registered in the June quarter.¹⁹³

At the 1891 census, age 22, he was single, living at home in Birmingham and working as a General labourer.

At the 1901 census, age 32, he was single, living at home in Birmingham and working as a saw maker at a Saw Mill.

He may be the William who married Ann Alexander in 1902; registered at King's Norton in the December quarter.¹⁹⁴

At the 1911 census they were living in Birmingham.¹⁹⁵

Herbert Canadine (1877-1955). Herbert Percy. The son of James and Eliza. He was born the 17th September 1877; registered in Birmingham in the December quarter 1877.²⁰⁰

At the 1881 census, age 3, he was living at home in Birmingham
At the 1891 census, age 13, he was living at home in Birmingham and working as an errand boy
At the 1901 census, age 23, he was living at home in Birmingham and working as a Wood turner

Herbert emigrated to the USA with his mother in 1904.

*Herbert emigrated to the US on the Etruria leaving Liverpool 24th April 1904 for New York, with Eliza Canadine and Eliza "Annie" Barber (called Canadine on the ship's manifest)
Herbert married Bessie Bartlett (born February 13, 1880 in Dorset) in about 1911. Herbert and Bessie did not have any children.*

Herbert returned to the UK for a visit in 1911.²⁰¹

Baby Boy Canadine (b.1884). The son of James and Eliza. Possibly born when Eliza was in her Fifties. He was said to have died at the age of about 5 of the measles.^{209 210}

William Canadine (1804-1846). The son of Abraham and Martha. He was born on the 8th June 1804 in Chaddesley Corbett.²¹¹

He may be the William who died, age 42, in 1846; registered at Shrewsbury in the June quarter.²¹²

Anne Canadine (1806-1827). The daughter of Abraham and Martha. She was christened in Chaddesley Corbett on the 30th April 1806²¹³. She died, aged 21, in 1827 and was buried at Belbroughton.²¹⁴

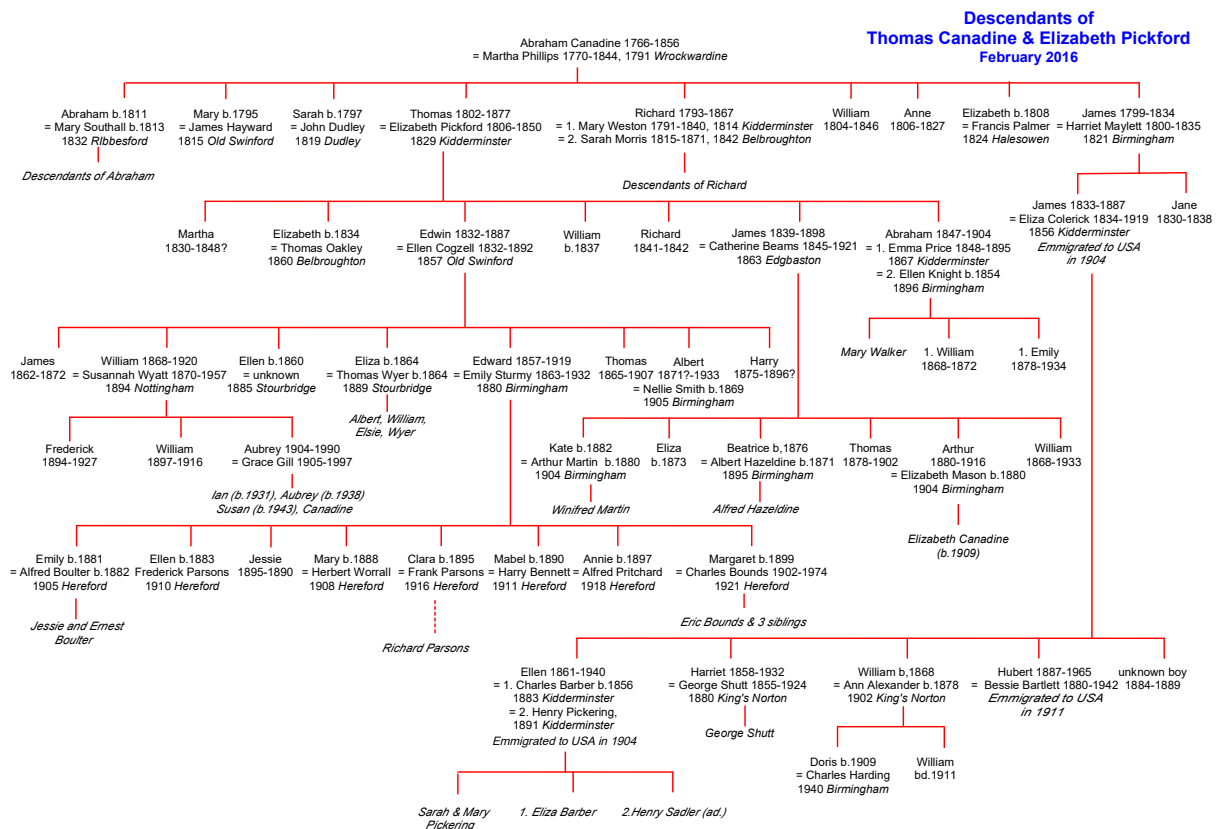
A memorial at Belbroughton mentioned Anne.

She may be the Elizabeth Canadine who married Francis Palmer on the 17th March 1824; registered at Halesowen.²¹⁶
