Joseph Rushgrove & Mary Humphreys and their descendants

Updated August 2019

There are branches of the family in England, Wales, USA, and Australia. Most present day Rus(h)groves are descended from the children of Joseph Rushgrove (1788-1852) and Hannah Walker (1792-1857) who were Nail makers and lived in the small town of Kington in Herefordshire where most of their children were born.

This document covers one of their children Joseph (1828-1905) and his descendants many of whom emigrated to the USA in the late 19th century.

There is only brief information for those born after 1920. Most information is from public sources.

Early origins in America

Most of the Rusgroves in the USA are descendants of the children of Joseph Rusgrove (1828-1905) and Mary Humphreys who in 1881 were living in Smethwick, near Birmingham, England. Joseph was a Blacksmith and Mary was running a shop. In about 1887 their son Thomas emigrated to the USA and settled on the East coast in South Connecticut in the Shelton, Derby and Ansonia area; about 50 miles from New York. Some of the other children followed their brother a few years later. Joseph and Mary joined their children in the USA in about 1890. An 1888 directory for Ansonia shows three of the brothers Edmund, John and Joseph living and working in the area.

By 1892 one of the brothers, John, and his wife Mary Cornforth had moved to Waterbury (a few miles further North) and it is from their children that most of the present-day Rusgroves in the USA are descended. There have been Rusgroves in Connecticut ever since.

Joseph's niece Charlotte (b.1863) and his nephew Henry William (b.1867) children of his brother Abraham also emigrated to the USA in about 1890; they and their descendants are covered in a separate document.

- The Naugatuck Valley was a thriving industrial are in the 1880's producing brass and copper products, iron castings and foundry products.

1. Joseph Rushgrove (1828-1905) & Mary Humphreys

Joseph Rusgrove (1828-1905). Also Joseph Jr. The son of Joseph Rusgrove and Hannah Walker. The second son with this name. He was baptised on the 11th May 1828 at Waterloo Row, Kington.¹

There was a thriving nail making business in Kington. Sunset row and Waterloo row were streets of small stone cottages built in the 1820's, for nail makers, by the local Iron Foundry which moved to the Sunset area as business was expanding in 1820. We think that Joseph's father moved the family to Kington in about 1826.

At the 1841 census Joseph was working as a Nailer, aged 13, in Kington.²

Joseph married Mary Anne Humphreys (1829-1921) on the 27th February 1848 at Ludford; registered at Ludlow in the March quarter.³ ⁴ The marriage was by Banns. Joseph, age 20, a batchelor, was living at Ludford and Mary, age 18, a spinster, at Leominster. Joseph was described as a Nailer. His father was Joseph Rusgrove a Nailer. Mary's father was Robert Humphreys a Waggoner. The witnesses were George Rusgrove and Eliza Rusgrove; Joseph's brother and his wife.

Ludford is about 20 miles North East of Kington just south of Ludlow.

At the 1851 census they were living at Frog Lane, Ludlow.5

They probably moved to Welshpool in the late 1850's. At the 1861 census they were living in Welshpool.⁶

They moved again, to Birmingham, in about 1865.

Joseph was described as a Bolt maker on his son Thomas' marriage certificate in 1869.7

At the 1871 census they were living at 162 Cranford Street, Harborne, Birmingham.⁸ Joseph was described as a Bolt forger.

Ellen and Matilda (in 1861) may be the same daughter. 'Fanny' is also known as Frances.

At the 1881 census Joseph and Mary were living at 53 James Turner Street, Birmingham along with younger sons Edmund, John and Charles. Their daughter Frances (Fanny) and her husband Charles Cox were also living at the same address but as a separate household. Joseph was described as a blacksmith.⁹

Mary was born in Steventon, Herefordshire in 1829. She was listed in Kelly's directory of 1880 as: *Mrs*Page 4 of 39

Mary Rushgrove, shopkeeper, James Turner St, Foundry Road, Winson Green. 10

On his son Thomas' marriage certificate (second marriage) in 1887 Joseph was described as a Bolt maker.

Joseph emigrated to Connecticut, USA in 1890 and Mary followed him a year later. They were following their sons and daughter who had emigrated a few years earlier around 1886/87 to the Shelton, Derby and Ansonia area of New Haven county in Connecticut (about 50 miles from New York).

Mary appears on an immigration list for 1890.11

Susan (Bagley) is the wife of Charles (b.1869) - she was back in England by the 1891 census (see below); Alice is their daughter. Ellen is a daughter of Joseph and Mary

It is not clear who Charles and William are.

Joseph and Mary were listed on the 1900 USA census living with their son Edmund and his wife Alice in Wallingford, New Haven. Joseph was described as born in May 1928, aged 72, married 52 years. He had been in the USA 10 years and was not a Naturalised US citizen.¹²

Mary was described, as born in July 1829, age 69, the mother of 13 children with 5 still living. She had been in the USA 9 years. The UK censuses of 1851-1871 list 8 children and Mary (1862-1866) did not appear on a census; so 4 are currently unaccounted for and probably died as infants.

Joseph died in 1905 and is buried in Pine Grove Cemetery, Ansonia, Connecticut. 13

At the 1910 census Mary, aged 79, was widowed and living with her grandson Charles Cox and his family in Ansonia, Connecticut. She was described as the mother of 13 children with 3 now living.¹⁴

At the 1920 census Mary was living with another grandson Walter (the census says son but this must be wrong), aged 91, in Shelton, Connecticut. Mary was described as a naturalised US citizen and a Widow. 15 Mary died in 1921, aged 92, and is buried at the Riverside Cemetery, Shelton. 16

Joseph and Mary had eight children.

Jane Rusgrove (1849-1864). The daughter of Joseph and Mary. She was born in 1849; registered at Ludlow in the June quarter. She was christened at St. Laurence, Ludlow on the 24th April 1849. They were living in Old Street. Joseph is described as a Nailer. ¹⁷ 18 19

At the 1851 census, age 1, she was living with her parents at Frog Lane, Ludlow.²⁰ At the 1861 census, age 11, she was living at home in Welshpool.

Jane died in Birmingham in 1864; registered in the December quarter and was buried at Witton Cemetery.²¹ ²²

Thomas Rushgrove (1851-1906). Thomas William. The son of Joseph and Mary. He was born in

1851; registered at Ludlow in the December quarter.²³ He was christened in Ludlow on the 1st November 1851.²⁴

At the 1861 census, age 9, he was living at home in Welshpool.

Thomas married Rachel Maria Hart (1849-1883) on the 27th September 1869 at St. Martin's, Birmingham.²⁵ He was living in Bradford Street Birmingham and was described as a Bolt Maker.²⁶ Rachel was described as a spinster and a minor and was living in Edgbaston Street, Birmingham. Her father was Robert Harta Railway officer. The witnesses to her marriage were John Collins and Matilda Sophie Hart.

Rachel was born in 1849 in Gloucester. Rachel had a brother Thomas Alexander Hart who married Elizabeth Cornforth in Birmingham in about 1870. This Elizabeth may be a sister or other relative of Mary Hannah Cornforth who married Thomas' brother John in Birmingham in 1885.²⁷

At the 1871 census they were living at 164 Cranford Street, Harborne. This was next door to Thomas' parents who lived at 162.²⁸

William Hart was possibly Rachel's brother.

At the 1881 census Thomas and Rachel were living at Cranford Terrace, Harborne.²⁹

Rachel was also registered as a patient of William Grant at King's Norton on the 1881 census; she was enumerated twice.

Joseph was Thomas' younger brother not his son. Walter and Emily were Joseph's children

Rachel died, aged 34, in King's Norton, Birmingham, registered in the December quarter 1883.30

After Rachel died Thomas re-married in 1887 and emigrated to the USA, probably in the same year, and settled in the Shelton, Derby and Ansonia area of Connecticut.

Thomas married Harriet Elizabeth Hughes (1857-1918) on the 28th October 1887 at St. John, Ladywood; registered at Birmingham in the December quarter.^{31 32} Thomas, age 36, a widower was living at 2 Ingestone Street, Birmingham. He was described as a bolt maker. His father was Joseph Rusgrove a Bolt Maker. Harriet, age 27, a spinster, was living at Hampton Court, Icknield Port Road. Her father was Thomas Hughes a Tinner. The witnesses were Moses Giles and Ellen Letitia Farmer.

Harriet's date of birth is not clear; it may be between 1857 and 1860.

Ellen Farmer was Thomas' younger sister who married Charles Farmer.

It is probably Harriet who is recorded as travelling to England in 1899

On the 1900 USA census Thomas was described as: Head of household, born in England in October 1851, aged 49. 13 years in the USA. Renting a boarding house at 4b? Liberty Street, Ansonia, New Haven. Also with him were Harriet E Rusgrove, wife, born in England, aged 40. 13 years in the USA. The mother of 10 children with 3 now living.³³

Two children were living at home: *Alice Rusgrove*, daughter born in England in September? 1885, aged 15, single. *Florence Rusgrove*, daughter, born in Connecticut in October 1892, aged 7. There was 1 servant and 10 boarders also in the boarding house. These are the only children we have currently identified.

Thomas was listed in a Derby directory of 1890 as:-

His brothers Edmund, John and Joseph were also living in Ansonia.

Two Ellis Island records of 1902 and 1904 show Harriet arriving in New York from the UK; presumably after trips back home to Smethwick.³⁵

Harriet Rusgrove, arrived on the 24th April 1902, aged 39, married. A US citizen. Travelled on the Oceanic from Liverpool. Previous residence: Smethwick.

The outward departure lists in England also record her sailing on the Oceanic.³⁶

Her daughter Florence was also travelling with her.

There was a further trip from Liverpool in 1904.

Harriet Elizabeth Rusgrove, age 42 years 2 months, arrived in New York on 30th March 1904 in the Oceanic departing from Liverpool.

Harriet was described as married and heading for Ansonia. She had more than \$30 and had been in the USA before. Her home was East Derby Avenue and she was joining a relative.

Thomas died, age 54, in 1906 at Ansonia, Connecticut. He is buried at the Pine Grove Cemetery. 37

Harriet died, age 61, in 1918, at Shelton, Fairfield County, Connecticut. She is buried at the Riverside Cemetery.³⁹ ⁴⁰

Thomas had two children with Rachel (Emily b.1889, Matilda b.1883) and two children with Harriet

(Alice 1885-1969), Florence (1893-1977).

Joseph Rusgrove (1854-1919). Joseph Henry. Known as Henry. The son of Joseph and Mary. He was baptised on the 22nd February 1854 at Ludlow; registered at Ludlow in the March quarter. His father was described as a 'Nailer'.⁴¹

At the 1861 census, age 7, Joseph was living at home in Welshpool.

At the 1871 census Joseph was living at home at Cranford Terrace, Harborne, age 17, and was described as a Bolt forger.

Joseph married Harriet Maria Watts, born 1856, in Birmingham in the September quarter, in 1877.⁴³

At the 1881 census they were living at Cranford Terrace, Harborne, Birmingham with their two children Walter age 3 and Emily aged 4 months. They shared the house with Joseph's brother Thomas and his family. Joseph was described as Bolt Forger and Harriet as a Bolt screwer.

Joseph is listed on a Birmingham electoral register of 1885.44

Joseph emigrated to America in about 1886/1887 and settled in the Shelton, Derby and Ansonia area of Connecticut.

Harriet was listed as arriving in New York on the ship the 'City of Richmond' in 1889. 45

Joseph became a US citizen on the 26th October 1896.47

At the 1900 census they were living in Derby, New Haven.⁴⁸

'Mary' probably refers to 'Harriet Maria'.

In the 1906 Derby directory Joseph was listed as an employee of the 'New Haven' company and was a householder living at 62 Oak. Also boarding there were Joseph Rusgrove employee of the 'Ansonia' company and Walter Rusgrove a labourer.⁴⁹

In 1913, 1915 and in the 1918 directory, when Joseph was about 64, he was described as a farmer and householder living at 'Huntingdon Rd off Reservoir'. The 1916 directory had the following entry.⁵⁰

Joseph died, age 65, in 1919 and was buried at the Riverside Cemetery, in Shelton, Fairfield, Connecticut.⁵¹

Joseph and Harriet had seven children: Walter(1878-1936), Emily(1881-1943), Joseph (1882-1948), Mary (1886-1963), John (1887-1938), Harriet (1890-1951), Luke (b.1892).

Frances Rusgrove (b.1856). Frances Fanny. The daughter of Joseph and Mary. She was born in 1856; registered at Ludlow in the June quarter.⁵² She was christened on the 1st April 1856.⁵³

At the 1861 census, age 5, Frances was at home in Welshpool.

At the 1871 census Frances was at home in Harborne and working as Bolt Screwer, age 15.

Frances married Charles H Cox on the 14th February 1874 at St. Mary's, Birmingham; registered in the March guarter.⁵⁴

At the 1881 census they were living at 53 James Turner Street in Birmingham. Charles, aged 26, was described as a Machine Fitter; Fanny's age was given as 25. There were no children living with them in 1881.⁵⁶

Fanny's parents and her younger brothers and sisters were also living at No.53 but as a separate household.

Ellen Rusgrove (b.1859). Ellen Letitia. The daughter of Joseph and Mary. She was born in 1859; registered at Montgomery in the December quarter.⁵⁷

At the 1861 census, age 1, Ellen was at home in Welshpool (but registered as Matilda) At the 1871 census, age 11, Ellen was at home in Smethwick.

Ellen married Charles Farmer in 1879; registered at Birmingham in the December quarter.⁵⁸

At the 1881 census they were living in Birmingham.⁵⁹

A 'Puddler' was a wrought iron worker.

Ellen was a witness for her brother Thomas' second marriage in 1887.

We know of one child: William Farmer (b.1881)

Mary Rusgrove (1862-1866). Mary Ann Emily. The daughter of Joseph and Mary. She was born in 1862; registered at Montgomery in the March quarter.⁶⁰

Mary died, aged 4, in 1866; registered at King's Norton in the June quarter.⁶¹

Edmund Rusgrove (1864-1938). Edmund George. Also known as Edward. Also Rusgrool. The son of Joseph and Mary. He was born in 1864; registered in Birmingham in the June quarter.⁶²

At the 1871 census, age 6, census he was living at home in Harborne.

At the 1881 census, age 16, he was living at home in James Turner Street and working as a Tube Drawer.

There was a marriage listed for an Edmund George Rusgrove in Birmingham in 1884 to Mary Alice Bacon. It may be that his marriage in the USA was his second marriage.⁶³ 64

His father was Joseph Rusgrove, Bolt forger. Mary was described as age 20, a spinster, Screw maker, residence: Green Street. Her father was Thomas Cornforth a Wire drawer. The witnesses were Edward George Rusgrove and Edith Hughes. ⁷⁸ Edward was John's brother.

Mary was born in Birmingham on the 16th January 1867.79

They moved to the USA in 1887 and their second son Lewis was born in Connecticut in 1888. John appears in a Derby Business directory for 1889/90 and in 1890/91. He was employed by Osborne & Cheesman a local brass engineering company and was living at 243 Sugar, B Ansonia.⁸⁰

His occupation was given as a 'Fitter' and his intended destination was Wallingford, Connecticut. He was not a US Citizen at that stage and gave the reason for his travel as a 'Protracted sojourn'. On ship he shared Steerage No.4 with a Mr John R Roberts.⁸²

John was listed on the 1900 USA census at Waterbury City, New Haven County, Connecticut and was living at 12 Jeffrey? Avenue. The census states that he was born in England in August 1867, age 33, married 15 years. He emigrated in 1893 and had been in the USA 7 years. He was a Machinist. The house was rented. Although they originally came to the USA in 1887 and went back to the UK at least twice; after their son John was born in 1892 and again before son Robert was born in 1895. Later in 1920 John says that they emigrated in 1887 which seems to be his first visit.⁸³

Smethwick, a large and populous manufacturing hamlet, forms the northern division of Harborne parish, and is distant from three to four miles W by N of Birmingham, near the Dudley road, the Birmingham Canal, and the Stour Valley Railway which has a station here. It includes the southern part of Spon Lane, many extensive iron works, and two large glass works. The Summit Bridge, on the canal, near Galton Hall (the residence of John Freeth, Esq) is a neat iron structure of one arch. The Birmingham Plate Glass Works, on the south side of the canal, employs 350 workpeople. Chance Brothers & Co's extensive Glass Works, in Spon Lane, are the largest crown and sheet glass works in England, and employ about 1200 hands. Here was made nearly all the glass for the Crystal Palace, erected in London in 1851. Messrs Fox, Henderson & Co, were the contractors for building this immense structure, and nearly all the ironwork used in its construction was manufactured at their extensive Iron Works at Smethwick & Woodside, where they employ from 1000 to 2000 hands. Here are about a dozen other foundries and iron works, for the manufacture of bar, rod, and sheet iron; steel, cast and wrought iron articles, machinery, etc, and here is the large foundry which forms part of James Watt & Co's celebrated steam engine manufactory. Most of the iron works here have been established during the last 20 years. They give employment to many of the inhabitants of the surrounding parishes. Many new streets are now in course of formation, and the bustle created by the iron and glass works, and the extensive traffic on the canal, give Smethwick the air of an important town.


